Day 1, Saturday 30 March 2019

Depart Christchurch 8:15AM - Arrive Norfolk 1:40PM

Please be at Christchurch International Airport at least 2 hours prior to your departure flight. Travel is via Brisbane with Air New Zealand. You will have 1 hour & 10 minutes in Brisbane before continuing with Air NZ to Norfolk Island. On arrival you need to collect your checked luggage and clear customs and immigration. Once in the main terminal you will be met by our local ground operator - Pinetree Tours and transferred to your accommodation for the next seven nights. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure. A hire car will be waiting for you at your accommodation and insurance for one driver has been included. Petrol is payable direct. Dinner tonight is own arrangements.

Day 2, Sunday 31 March 2019 (D)

Half Day Orientation Tour/Welcome Function
