### 8. Summerset National Championships 2021:

David has sent an update on National's preparations after a meeting with Marlborough committee. There will be a feature mat again this year- thanks to Ron and Rae Inglis for sponsoring this.

Preparation of the payment forms to be done for umpires and also for winners of the event this year for refund of entry fee next year.

Accommodation to be booked for David Edgar, Neil Anderson and Graham Low for Thursday night at Commodore Court Motel. A meet and greet will be held with MIBC and NZIB on Friday night at 6.30pm in RSA section of Clubs Marlborough.

There will be a quiz night on Tuesday and the District Challenge on Thursday night.

Umpires meeting Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June at 7.30pm in RSA section of Clubs Marlborough and a coaching meeting on Sunday night venue to be confirmed. A mat and bowls will be required for this session. An open forum will also be held on Monday night for all participants.

Prizes, Certificates, Special prizes and badges to be organized.

Entries close together with payment on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> May.

### 9. Other National Events:

Mixed Fours must be 2 men and 2 women. Mixed Pairs must be 1 man and 1 woman. All other events are any combination. District entry forms for all events will be sent out shortly- host districts need to come back to Helen with costs of meals etc for the forms.

# 10. **Police Vetting:**

The Executive went into Committee for discussion for 15 minutes.

The issues with phone numbers for Real me has been sorted and the Executive gave Helen permission to use her account for NZIB vetting forms. Information on what will be provided to NZIB will also be asked from NZ Police. There will be zero tolerance for those breaking the policies once written.

It is recommended that all District coaches and those working with young persons should be Police Vetted to comply with the Vulnerable Children's Act of Child Welfare. New policies are to be developed which must be adhered to be Districts and the NZIB Constitution and Code of Conduct may require changing to accommodate this. The policy will also include the action required if there is a misappropriation of funds. To be made by October to advise Districts at AGM of changes to constitution and Codes of conduct.

# 11. 1-5 Year Playing Status:

A request to clarify the status of 1-5 Year players has been made from Hutt Valley re the 2020 year and if this would counted as a played year.

"As no affiliation fees were paid last season and a number of clubs closed 2020 would not be counted as a playing year and all 1-5 Year Players would remain at the same level as 2019"

### 12. Summerset Sponsorship:

# 13. Publicity:

A newsletter is being sent out shortly. There will also be a further one in two week's time dedicated to the Nationals. Destination Marlborough to be given the back page of the Nationals newsletter on 4 days in view of their great sponsorship.

#### 14: Roadshows:

Two road shows have been held to date. Hawkes Bay had 10 people – a good conversation held and a request to relook at a bulk insurance schedule for clubs. Southland had about 30 attendees and a wide range of topics were discussed – attracting new players, varying events to keep interest, bringing a new person along to bowls.

Several other districts have shown interest and dates will be decided with them.

# 15. Coaching Development:

A open discussion / forum for coaches and development officers will be held during the Nationals with a possible view to revamping the Coaching Manual. David Edgar to organize a venue for Sunday night 7pm.

### 16. Umpires Exams:

15 Applications have been received from Manawatu (2), North Harbour (2), Taranaki (3), Nelson (2), Southland (4) and Rotorua (2). Exams will be held week commencing 3<sup>rd</sup> May. Neil Anderson is holding the Umpires badges and will send them up to Barry Chapman. The Umpires forum is being held on Friday night at 7.30pm at Clubs Marlborough.

# 17. Law Books and Draw Books:

Neil Anderson will bring items to the Nationals to be given to Helen. There are very few law books left now and orders are still being received. A review of the law book will be undertaken prior to reprinting. Any submissions from districts are to be received by 1 October to be discussed at October meeting and circulated. Law books will be reprinted and available at the AGM in December. Draw books also to be updated and available at AGM.

# 18. Live Streaming:

### 19. General Business:

- 1. **Indoor Bowls Measuring Equipment:** A request to know where to purchase measuring equipment for Indoor Bowls has been received. Several names were supplied to Helen as a guide.
- 2. **Sport New Zealand:** Submissions for the annual review have closed. We are now awaiting a response from Craig MacFarlane.
- 3. **Poverty Bay East Coast:** Sharon Hook has visited the region and reported that they are hoping to start a club for Junior Bowlers.
- 4. **International vs Australia:** To be held in Sydney May 2021. Nominations to be sent out after the Nationals but it was agreed that all members of the squad would need to be fully vaccinated for Covid-19 prior to selection. There will be 7 men, 7 women plus one manager.
