MARK CAMERON VISIT:

The contract with Bowls NZ is due to end on 12th March 2023. Mark Cameron attended the meeting to discuss the future of the relationship. The relationship between the two organizations has worked well in the last three years and could be extended for NZIB to be able to use all 14 staff and expertise of Bowls NZ plus contractors.

DRAFT CALENDAR 2023:

Graham Low tabled a draft calendar which was discussed in depth. Graham will incorporate a couple of changes as agreed and it will be circulated.

The North vs South Tour will not take place in 2023. The North vs South event will be held and a short promotional tour to one or two districts will be considered but not a full tour as the cost is prohibitive.

AGM:

A request for the AGM to be live streamed was made by one of Liz Morrow's districts. This will be investigated. Two Remits have been received - Bay of Plenty re Inter-Provincial Competition and Manawatu re Remits close off by 31 July.



A reply from the Executive to both remits will be forwarded to the districts with the AGM paperwork speaking against both remits.

NZIB office has been asked to book flights for two delegates only.
