All of last years National Champions are back to defend their titles in Ashburton, barring the Don Simpsons Champion Masters Fours team.

The Diamond Jubilee Nationals have also seen some old names

come out of the woodwork for "another crack" at winning a national title- one of those who're giving it another go is Gary Lawson.

Gary is currently sitting on four national indoor titles, and if he is able to win his fifth would become the only player to hold both outdoor and indoor Gold Stars.

Other players on the hunt for their Gold Stars this nationals include the legendary Kevin Boothby (who won his first title in 1972 and continues to be a strong contender), Joseph Zino, Shelley Jacombs and Simon Thomas.

A NEW CLUB TAKES FLIGHT IN OTAUTAHI CHRISTCHURCH

The Otautahi Owls are the new indoor bowling Club on the metaphorical block-We spoke to Foundation member (and current Mat Black) Kylie Gould about "The Owls"

NZIB: Why "The Owls"?

KG: We liked the idea of a mascot and we wanted something that felt local and relevant to us.

Owls ticked all the boxes, they are wise, sharp eyed, skilled hunters and come out at night (just like us) and as a bonus, 'Owls' has a nice alliteration with Ōtautahi.

It wasn't until after we'd settled on the name that one bright spark pointed out: "An owl is what you get when you take the BS out of bowls."

NZIB: How long did it take to set up your club?

KG: Getting set up took us around six months, working away at it casually to get everything in place.

We knew we wanted to register as an incorporated society to access better funding opportunities, so the first things on our to-do list were sorting out the constitution, opening a bank account, and getting our IRD numbers and getting that passed our parliament (our committee is called a parliament like a group of owls).

After that came the funding applications, designing uniforms, setting up the website and, of course, the most important bit: recruiting some members!

We're now 22 strong, with members ranging from Owlets (juniors), Fledglings (1-5 years), Owls (full members), and Nesters (60+).

NZIB: You're a brand new Club- started in the 21st Century- what are you doing differently to our older Clubs?

KG: We're trying out a few fresh ideas to create a fun, social atmosphere at our hoot nights (club nights) with music playing in the background and using a projector to display teams and draws.

We've also introduced new warm up challenges like Tic Tac Jack, and other drills disguised as games.

Another way we're mixing things up is by running year-round play. We don't want to lose momentum (or people!) over summer, so we play once a fortnight all through the year, and our championships are held on weekend days to keep things flexible and accessible.

We've also ditched the old-school pen-and-paper noticeboard in favour of going digital. Our website is where members can sign up for events any time they like, keep track of what they've registered for, and access membership forms, calendars, and more all in one place.
