CHAMPIONSHIP DETAILS

The following are the details of the NZ Island Championships to be played in Rotorua on the 31st May 1st and 2nd June 2025

PAIRS – 10 ENDS or 45 MINUTES

Section play Saturday 31st May at 8.30am. Post Section, approximately 2.00 pm Saturday afternoon and evening up to and including the final.

FOURS – 10 ENDS or 60 MINUTES

Section play Sunday 1st June at 8.30am. Post Section, approximately 3.30pm Sunday afternoon and evening up to and including the final.

TRIPLES – 10 ENDS OR 45 MINUTES

Section play Monday 2nd June at 8.30am. Post section, approximately 2.00pm Monday afternoon and evening up to and including the final.

The semi-finals and finals of each event shall consist of the same number of ends as in Rule 2, with an additional 10 minutes added to the time limit.

TIME LIMITS: SEMIFINALS AND FINAL

Pairs: Semifinals and Final 55 minutes

Fours: Semifinals and Final 70 minutes

Triples: Semifinals and Final 55 minutes

Section Sheets

Section sheets will be placed in a prominent position as near as possible to each Block. At the completion of each round, officials will record the results of each game on these sheets and it will be the responsibility of the team or player to see that their score is correctly recorded.

Any errors should be notified to the Umpire in Charge or Hall Controller immediately.

Section Winners and those with five or more points

shall qualify for post-section play. Section play shall consist of four games, two points shall be awarded for a win and one point for a draw.

Your Results

At the end of section play all players are requested to make sure that their results have been correctly recorded.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR ISLAND CHAMPIONSHIPS

COMPETITORS

1. All competitors must be bona fide members of a Club registered through their Member District to New Zealand Indoor Bowls (Inc.) or be a member of an approved overseas Indoor Bowls Organisation.

GAMES

1. Section and post-section games up to and including the quarter-finals shall consist of:
Pairs: (six bowls) 10 ends with a time limit of 45 minutes, the Leads shall bowl first, followed by the Skips.
Triples: (six bowls) 10 ends with a time limit of 45 minutes, the Leads shall bowl first, followed by the Twos, and then the Skips.
Fours: 10 ends with a time limit of 60 minutes, the Leads shall bowl first, followed by the Twos, then the Threes and the Skips.
2. The semi-finals and finals of each event shall consist of the same number of ends as in Rule 2, with an additional 10 minutes added to the time limit.
3. In the event of a draw in the semi-finals or final, a deciding end shall be played.

SECTION PLAY

1. Players or teams for each event shall be drawn into sections of five in such a manner as will ensure, as far as possible, that no more than one player, or team from the same Member District shall be in the same section.
2. Section play shall consist of four games. Two points shall be awarded for a win and one point for a draw. The results of each game will be displayed on wall charts, and it is the responsibility of the player, or Skip, to ensure that their results are correctly recorded.
3. Section winners and those with five or more points shall qualify for post-section play.
4. Players, or teams, who have been drawn to play in a particular section shall not change to play in any other section without permission of the Controlling Authority given prior to the start of the event. (Permission will only be given in exceptional circumstances). Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the disqualification of the players, or teams, concerned for that event.

POST SECTION PLAY

1. The order of post-section play shall be decided by a random draw.
2. Post-section play shall be conducted on the 'sudden death' principle.
3. In the event of a drawn game in post-section play, a deciding end will be played.

CONDUCT OF GAMES

1. All games shall be played in accordance with the Laws of the Game.
2. All games shall be played with the jack and bowls as placed on the mat by the Controlling Authority.
3. All games shall commence and finish with a time signal.
4. At the completion of a game the name of the winning player or Skip shall be recorded

in the appropriate place at the top of the score card with the losing player, or Skip, signing at the bottom. The completed scorecard is to be left on the mat. Failure to correctly complete the scorecard will render both teams, liable to be defaulted for that game by the Controlling Authority. Signing of the scorecard shall be proof that there is no dispute.

DEFAULTS

1. Any player not at their mat when the commencing time signal sounds shall be defaulted for that particular game. A team which contains a defaulted player is, therefore, automatically defaulted. The scorecard shall be signed by the Skip, in the appropriate place, marked 'WON BY DEFAULT' and left on the mat.

GENERAL

1. No player shall play on a mat during an event unless they are drawn to play on that mat at that time. Spectators are not permitted to play on mats.
2. Smoking is prohibited on the floor of the playing area of venues used for championship play. Players who are warned once for smoking during a session of play shall be defaulted for the game they are playing, if they offend again. Smoking shall be confined to designated smoking areas as decided by the Controlling Authority.
3. Any competitor who is considered unfit to play for any reason, will be liable to disqualification by the Controlling Authority.
4. Intoxicating liquor shall be confined to those areas set aside by the Controlling Authority for sale or consumption.
5. Law 14(g) shall be strictly adhered to. Soles and heels of footwear shall be of flat, smooth or fine treaded and pliable material that will not carry foreign matter or cause damage to the mats. Play in bare feet or jandals is not permitted. Where there is any doubt about the suitability of footwear the Controlling Authority shall be the sole judge.
6. An acceptable standard of dress must be worn by players attending any NZIB Indoor Bowls Championship. Where there is any doubt about the suitability of dress the Controlling Authority shall be the sole judge.

VISUALLY IMPAIRED PLAYERS AT NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

23. Any player registered with the New Zealand Blind and Visually Impaired I.B.A shall:
 - a) On notifying the Controlling Authority be permitted the assistance of a guide for play.
 - b) Only one guide will be permitted to any singles player or pair. In triples and fours the guide must be a member of the team.
 - c) A guide will be considered to be an extension of the players. The player will be responsible for any infringement of the Laws of the Game committed by the guide, and suffer any penalties incurred by such infringement.
 - d) From a position behind the bowling end of the mat and at the time the player has control of the playing area, a guide will have the right to:
 - (i) indicate to the player the distance of the head from the bowling end of the mat;
 - (ii) indicate the colour of the bowls to the player;

- (iii) assist the player in preparing for bowling of a bowl or jack;
- (iv) if requested by the player, assume the player's right to inspect the head;
- (v) if requested by the player, assume the player's obligations and/or duties under the Laws of the Game.

ALTERATION TO CONDITIONS

1. The Appropriate Authority shall have the right to amend times and/or conditions of play should they deem it necessary.
