Not very often does a NZ National Sporting Team beat Australia but that is what we will be hoping when the NZ Indoor Bowls team heads to Colac in Victoria for the bi-annual Test match 12-15 May.

The Lion Foundation New Zealand team will be trying to win the Henselite Trophy for an unprecedented seventh time in a row. New Zealand has won this trophy twelve times while Australia has been successful on just three occasions in 1976, 1979 and 1991. The country scoring the most wins over the three days wins the Henselite Trophy.

Upper Hutt Valley's Pat Hoult will captain the side for the fifth time. He made his debut in 1995 and has captained the team since 1997.
