INDOOR BOWLERS FEATURING IN WELLINGTON OUTDOOR SCENE.

A feature of Wellington Lawn Bowls this season has been the performance of a number of current and former prominent indoor bowlers. Included are:

Blake Signal - Former North Island Representative has been a regular member of the Wellington Representative team and was selected for the New Zealand Under-25 Team to play against Australia. Dale Lang - current New Zealand Representative and New Zealand Fours Champion has been a regular member of the Wellington Women's Development Team after outstanding performances at the New Zealand Championships where she qualified in the Singles and Pairs in strong sections containing International players. The highlight was combining with Angela Bell to beat New Zealand Reps Serena Matthews and Jan Malcolm in the pairs.

Angela Bell - Former NZ Maori Rep who has won the Wellington Open Fours and Pairs. Stephen Zino who won his third successive Champion of Champions 1 -5 years singles.

Throughout the country indoor bowlers are featuring well playing outdoor and at the Inter Club and Inter Centre Finals recently in Palmerston North the following names were noted.

Jan Philpott (Canterbury), Grant Catterick (Manawatu), Cliff Byrne (Manawatu), Lyn Metcalfe (Manawatu), Warren Fisher (Wairarapa), Sean Johnson (Wanganui), Andrew Curtain (Canterbury), Stephen Ditfort (Canterbury), Nigel Godman (Canterbury), Alistair Keith (Otago), Kay Carr (Wellington), Graham Champion (Canterbury) and Mary Walker (Canterbury).

Winner of the Henselite Champion of Champions in 2005 Ali Forsyth won the Asia Pacific Singles Title and represented NZ against Australia and Gary Lawson is playing for NZ against Ireland and Scotland. It certainly goes to show that the grounding learnt in the indoor version of the game can be successfully transferred to the outdoor game.

A WIN AGAINST AUSTRALIA COMING UP?

Not very often does a NZ National Sporting Team beat Australia but that is what we will be hoping when the NZ Indoor Bowls team plays at Pukekohe in the bi-annual Test match 10-12 May. The Lion Foundation New Zealand team will be trying to win the Henselite Trophy for an unprecedented eighth time in a row. New Zealand has won this trophy thirteen times while Australia has been successful on just three occasions in 1976, 1979 and 1991. The country scoring the most wins over the three days wins the Henselite Trophy. Upper Hutt Valley's Pat Hoult will captain the side for the sixth time. He made his debut in 1995 and has captained the team since 1997. New Zealand is represented by 14 players – seven men and seven women who play in two events each. There are four bowlers making their first appearance in the National team-Maureen Pruden (WK), Carol Wright (AK), Rosemary Bennett (AS) and Richard Griffiths (CY). The others making up the team are: Suzann Burnand (BP); Sandra Keith (AS); Dale Lang (NW); Julie Thomas (CY); Dean Gilshnan (MN); Trevor Gould (UV); Simon Thomas (CY); & two recalled International bowlers Garry Flewitt (OT) & Blair Spicer (CY).
