GOOD SCHOOL COACHING BEING DELIVERED IN ASHBURTON




Following a successful 2008 School Coaching Programme, devised by the then NZIB coach, Michael Lawson, the Ashburton Association has had an outstanding response to a similar coaching series for the current season. A total of 7 schools are providing students for the two week schedule. Sessions last between 1 and 11/4 hours, with two schools

travelling to the host's stadium while the other schools are able to provide their own facilities on various days of the week. Close to 250 primary and intermediate age pupils are benefitting from the knowledge of 30 representative and enthusiastic bowlers, which also includes current South Island rep's Rosemary Bennett and Michael Lawson. Taking the coaching series to a successful conclusion will see the selection of 8 students from each school to play pairs, two games each day, of about half an hour's duration, on July 27th and August 10th and 24th.

COLLEGE SPORT EVENT IN WELLINGTON

80 secondary school students entered this popular event and not surprisingly the winner of the singles was new cap of the North Island team, Teri Anderson from Newlands College who beat Ashleigh Eden from Tawa College in the final. very well and we will be hoping to build on that success. The current Government has shown a very definite focus on sport in schools and if NZIB wishes to receive government grants it must improve it's delivery in this crucial area. Both of these events are hosted by the North Wellington IBA who are extremely supportive of the promotion of the game to juniors.
