HENSELITE TROPHY BACK HOME

The symbol of international indoor bowls competition between New Zealand and Australia has been recaptured by the Mat Blacks. Australia has held the trophy since 2009. NZ lost it at Broken Hill in New South Wales and then saw the Aussies defend it at Balclutha in South Otago two years later. This time the tables were turned, very convincingly, with New Zealand taking out the first day 16-6, going further ahead 35-9 on the second day, and completing the rout on the third day to make the final score 55-11. Past President Trevor Rayner called the Mat Blacks performance "focussed and disciplined". He said a feature of the New Zealand effort was their hard work, discipline and support for each other, on and off the mat. Without doubt another reason for the success was the professionalism Team Manager Pat Hoult bought to the team and the large number of NZ supporters who attended and made themselves heard!
