WELCOME TO THE 2014 SEASON

By the time you read this some clubs will already be up and running for 2014. We hope you, and all the others about to start, have a very successful season. We also hope you are making an effort to attract some new players this year. We know you are competing against television, the Internet, computer games etc, but we all need to keep trying to rebuild memberships. What about a push to attract families-maybe introduce a 3 generations tournament? How about taking a mat and bowls into a shopping mall and encouraging people to have a go. Make them available to your newer members and get them excited about improving their skills for the season ahead.

2014 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The National Championships return to Hawkes Bay this year for the first time in many years. Hastings hosted the 1953 Nationals (not that many years after the sport started – the first Nationals were in 1950) and Napier joined with Hastings to stage the 1958 event.



This year it's the turn of Taradale (which is part of Napier), with their magnificent stadium the Pettigrew Green Arena at 480 Gloucester Street. The twin cities Napier and Hastings have lots of attractions to fill in your leisure time, and there's plenty of accommodation.

Entries forms and posters have been distributed to Districts Secretaries so should be reaching your club soon. Why not make up a group and make sure it includes new members who have not been before. Once they have been they will be likely to return like so many of you do!

Remember entries for the Nationals close with District Secretaries on the $24^{\rm th}$ of April.

CHANGES TO NATIONALS FORMAT

Napier will be the scene this year for one of the biggest changes to the Nationals for some time. In the past, section play for the singles has taken place on Day 1, Saturday, with the event completed on the Monday. This year all the events will be over two consecutive days - Singles-Saturday/Sunday; Pairs Monday/



Tuesday and so on. One reason for the change is so players who compete but don't qualify can go home if not entered in other events. So far feedback has been positive, but we'll be interested in your feedback afterwards. Another change as a result of the survey conducted last year is that it will now be section winners or 6 points to qualify with drawn games being played out. Hopefully this will eliminate some of the "fixed draws" which have happened too many times

in the past.

DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT ROLES

These positions have worked well in Taranaki and Tauranga/ surrounding districts and NZIB is keen to assist Districts set up a similar role within their area. Craig Whiteside has been appointed National Development Manager and is available to come to your district and help you set up a workable model. It can be done and the future of the sport depends on Districts prepared to recognise the fact that changes must be made.

Blue and orange bowls are the "in colour" and will be on show at the National Championships and the Island Tour.
