NZ TEAM IS OFF TO THE UK

Just over three years ago Executive Member Trevor Rayner was doing some research to expand the opportunities to play Indoor Bowls Internationally and noticed that the English Carpet Bowls Association had a Festival of Bowls week each year at Potters Resort at Hopton-on-Sea in Norfolk.

He contacted the ECBA President Mike Walker to see if International players would be welcome at the event.

The response was positive and after exploratory visits in 2016 and 2017 by Nigel Warnes, Trevor and Linda Rayner and Avon Compton a NZ team will compete this year against England and Norway. Unfortunately Sweden and Denmark have withdrawn from the International.

The fours and pairs are played with qualifying rounds and the Singles are straight knock out.

The ECBA Festival of Bowls and World Cup will be played from Tuesday 15 May to Thursday 17 May

Team 1: Grant l'Ami (North Taranaki), Avon Compton (North Wellington), Gary Low (Southland), Teri Anderson (Waikato); **Team 2:** Ashley Diamond (Upper Hutt Valley), Paul Wright (Auckland), Sheree Holmes (Upper Hutt Valley) and Suzanne Mackie (Southland).

In the Pairs at the ECBZ event the combinations are Avon Compton & Paul Wright; Ashley Diamond & Sheree Holmes; Grant l'Ami and Suzanne Mackie and Gary Low and Teri Anderson. All players are playing Singles.

In addition there are 13 supporters attending the event of whom eight will be playing in the Festival of Bowls events.

This is an exciting development and we wish the team every success.

We are hoping that the events will be streamed here in New Zealand so bowlers can get to feel part of this investment which hopefully will lead to more opportunities of promoting the game in the future.

NOMINATIONS FOR ISLAND TEAMS

This year it will be the North Island Team touring the South Island in August. Nomination forms have been sent to districts and close on 18 May. There will be an added opportunity to make one of the Island teams as those representing NZ in the UK next month will not be considered. It will also be one of the last opportunities to impress the Selectors before the NZ Team is selected to play Australia in Invercargill next year. All indoor bowls supporters are welcome to go on this tour and it does cover most of the Island.

The land cost will be approximately \$1,100 for the ten days covering travel, accommodation, dinners and the odd lunch including Test Day. Contact National Office is you require any more details.
